## Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) (Project Action)

PROPOSAL: The Lynnwood Public Works Department has submitted an Environmental Review

Checklist (ERC) for the improvement of 204<sup>th</sup> Street SW, from the existing land use of a single-lane gravel residential road to a paved two-lane road with sidewalks and improved intersections and crosswalks at 76<sup>th</sup> Ave W. This site is a part of the public Right-of-Way. Approximately 11,000 square feet of site area will be cleared and grubbed, 1,500 cubic yards of roadway excavated, 130 tons of gravel borrow imported, and 60 cubic yards of

topsoil will be imported. There are no critical areas on-site for this proposal.
