9 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD,
10 WASHINGTON, TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT DISTRICT
11 ADOPTING A ONE YEAR BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF
12 LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT
13 DISTRICT FOR THE YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2011;
14 AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE,
15 SEVERABILITY, AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

18 WHEREAS, on May 24, 2010 the Lynnwood City Council did establish the
19 Lynnwood Transportation Benefit District; and,

21 WHEREAS, Chapter 36.73 RCW requires the Transportation Benefit District to
22 adopt an annual budget; and,

24 WHEREAS, the Transportation Benefit District Board provided notice and
25 conducted a public hearing on February 14, 2011, regarding a proposed budget for fiscal year
26 2011; NOW, THEREFORE,

28 THE BOARD OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON,
29 TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT DISTRICT, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

31 Section 1. The 2011 Budget for the Lynnwood Transportation Benefit District for the year
32 ending December 31, 2011 totaling \$190,000 is hereby adopted.



34 Section 2. Revenues and Expenditures. The budget sets forth totals of estimated revenues and
35 estimated expenditures of the Transportation Benefit District as summarized below:

Total Revenue - Washington State Department of Licensing	\$190,000
Expenditures	
Insurance - purchased through CIAW	\$1,700
Administration - legal and staff support (including 2010)	\$46,000
Transportation Improvements - Overlay Program, identified in the City of Lynnwood Six Year Transportation Improvement Plan	\$142,300
Total Expenditures	\$190,000

2 Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be
3 held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or
4 unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence,
5 clause or phrase or word of this ordinance.

7 Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after passage and
8 publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title.
